COMPETITION TASK SUMMARY

PILOT CHOICE – During dinner the night before all pilots must indicate their interest for the following day; the handicap they will compete with (i.e. wet or dry), which grade they want to fly in, or if they want a lay-day or an own-task day. This will determine how many grades we need to task the following day.

1. ORANGE PRIX

- Start line 5km long, perpendicular to track to first turn point, all competitors to be behind start line 1 min before start time
- Once the start line is open competitors must cross below the declared maximum QNH start altitude (close to launch release altitude) and with a declared maximum start ground speed
- Turn points will have 0.5km radius observation zones and a maximum QNH rounding altitude will be set for each turn point
- Finish line will be "Waikerie Finish" with a 5km radius and a declared minimum finish QNH altitude
- Competitors will place according to their finish order

2. JUICING GRADE

- Conventional AAT, AST or RUN tasks
- All competitors fly Juicing Grade on the first day

3. FRESH GRADE

- All competitors fly Fresh Grade on the final day
